### SHORT DESCRIPTION

*Dense deep fresh red colour. The nose shows red 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon, Meinert [www.enotriacoe.com](http://www.enotriacoe.com) Dense deep fresh red colour. The nose shows red berries, typical Cabernet herbs, spicy toasty oak and tobacco. Mouth filling and weighty but not clumsy on the palate, finishes crisp and lingering.*

### Climate:

Elgin is the coolest wine region in South Africa, well below Stellenbosch and other well-known wine regions of the Western Cape

### Soil:

ancient sandstone with coarse pieces of silica quartz and shales that are predominantly iron-rich.

### Vinification:

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. I believe Cabernet Sauvignon is particularly suited to our vineyard and thus important to showcase. Our soils, which are deep and well drained with high clay content, and the low yields define our wines. Vines receive supplementary irrigation. Average yield 5 tons/ha.

### MEINERT VINEYARDS

Wine is my means of expression, not just of myself but also such tangible aspects as our sites. As a young man I worked by chance for a few years as a journalist. I think I was searching for an artistic outlet and fortunately found it in winemaking, which began as a fascination with the product. Though I still dream of exploring other artistic endeavours I remain excited by the challenge of trying to make great wines.
